ATTENDANCE MATTERS!

We do fully understand that from time to time children may need a day off school due to illness, however, we would ask for all families to aim for 96-100% attendance for their child. Each school day is important - the curriculum is often fast-paced and missed learning can hinder their overall development, not only academically but also socially and emotionally.

We are a fully inclusive school and, as part of our statutory obligations, we meet with our Educational Welfare Officer (EWO) on a weekly basis with the aim of improving whole school attendance and to tackle persistent absenteeism.

Sometimes we are required to refer cases to the EWO in line with our statutory and legal obligations. We understand that children and families sometimes need support and we have lots of good ideas and strategies to support our families - no problem is too big or too small - we are happy to help. If you are invited to attend a meeting, this will be with Mrs Lucas, Mrs Lineker and the EWO. The aim of initial meetings is to provide support and create opportunities to cooperate with our families to improve the attendance of your child.

If you are concerned about your child's attendance please reach out to either Mrs Lineker, Mrs Lucas or Mrs Sargeant who will be able to offer support, guidance and advice to support your family.


Be in it to win it!
